The flu is here. Have a back-up plan for keeping your sick child at home. In order to keep the children and teachers in our schools healthy we need your cooperation. How do I know if my child has the flu?

You may have the flu if you have some or all of these symptoms:

- fever
- cough
- sore throat
- runny or stuffy nose
- body aches
- headache
- chills
- fatigue
- sometimes diarrhea and vomiting

Keep your sick child at home for at least 24 hours after they are fever free (without the use of anti fever medicine).

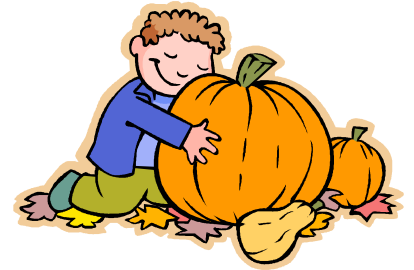
