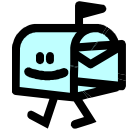

## Grocery Receipts

Each year St. William Campus receives much appreciated funds through our collection of Sentry Grocery Receipts. Here are a few updates on the Funds for Friends program. Only receipts with a "" sticker will qualify. You must ask for the sticker during check out. Your cashier will not automatically place a sticker on your receipt. If you have no sticker, you can discard your receipt. We collect receipts from **only** the following Sentry locations, *Fox Run, Meadowbrook, and Delafield*. Receipts are only good for 6 months from the date of checkout. Anything older than 6 months will not qualify. We no longer have to collect and turn in receipts from Pick N' Save. We receive funds automatically when you scan your Advantage Card. 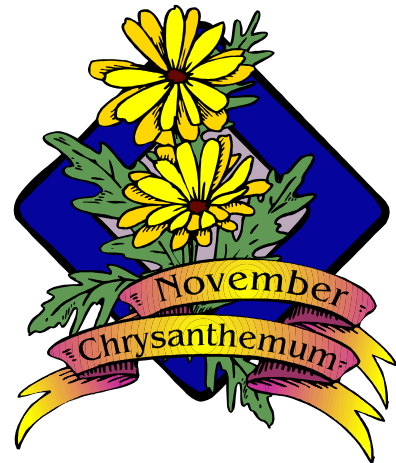
