
## Information Available in the School Office:

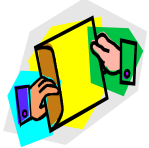
