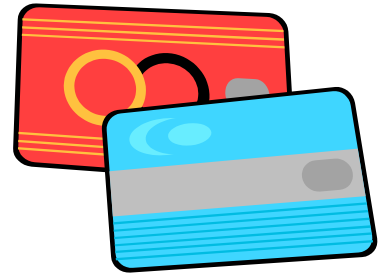
Town Hall Meeting – All are Invited to Attend

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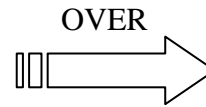
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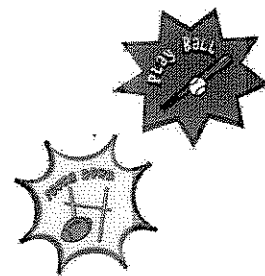

Dear Parents,

As your child's new Physical Education teacher, I'd like to introduce myself to you all, and provide you with a short background. I attended college at Concordia University Wisconsin, where I graduated with degrees in Physical Education, Adaptive Physical Education, Health, and Coaching. I played volleyball in college and have been a club coach at Milwaukee Rally VBC since 2006. Currently I am the Varsity Girls' Volleyball Coach at Waukesha South High School.

My goal is to make Physical Education fun, challenging, and worthwhile for my students. My lessons are skill-based, which means they focus on the breakdown of each activity. Students will learn sport specific skills, cooperation, and the positive effects of a healthy lifestyle while working in a safe, friendly environment.

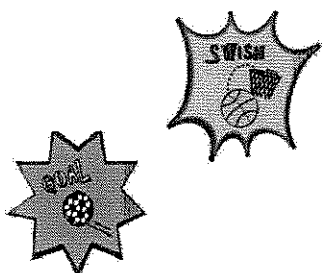
To begin the school year your child has been working very hard to get to know me, my rules and routines, and Phy Ed procedures. We have been playing cooperative games, working on boundaries, learning new rules, practicing locomotor skills, and, most importantly, participating in quality cardiorespiratory exercise.

As the quarter progresses, your student will be working on soccer skills and football skills. These will include learning how to: pass, dribble, trap, throw, catch, pull flags, etc. During these units students will play modified games that emphasize using these skills in addition to teamwork, cooperation, and sportsmanship.


My Dog May Be a Genius

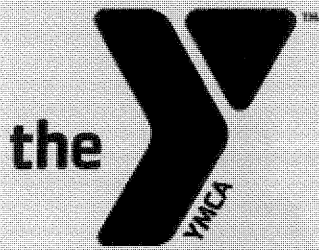
