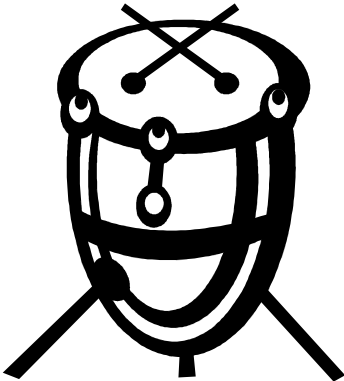
Words to Forget - I can't, I'll try, I have to; should have; could have; if only. Yes but; problem; difficult; impossible; I, me, my hate.

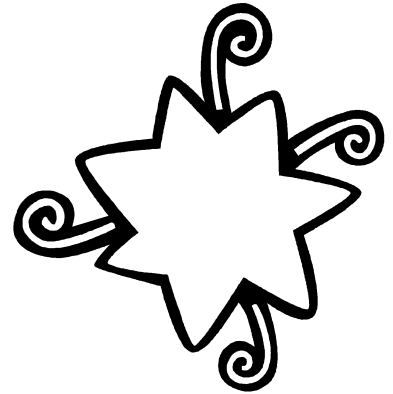
